

WATER FEES & CHARGES – RESIDENTIAL 2026-27



Residential customers should receive a water bill from us on a quarterly basis.

Your residential water bills are made up of fixed and variable charges:

- Fixed service charges – are annual charges that will be divided evenly across each of your bills for the year, for establishing and operating the water system.
- Variable water usage charges – are calculated and billed quarterly, based on the amount of water you use.

Prices are updated each financial year (which begins on 1 July and ends on 30 June).

Residential fees and charges are based on a standard 20mm residential service.

Your water usage is calculated across the year. All customers start in Tier 1, then as your cumulative water use increases during the year, you will progressively move into higher tiers. Your usage will reset to Tier 1 when your bill restarts on 1 July each year.

The vacant land charges (VLC) are service charges for establishing infrastructure and maintaining the water system to make drinking water available to your property prior to construction of a dwelling on your property. The VLC no longer applies once a metered connection is installed on your property.

The VLC is waived for the first 12 months from date of initial purchase of vacant lot land from the Developer. The VLC will also be applied should a property's water supply be disconnected from the mains water system.

NO CONNECTION TO THE WATER SUPPLY CAN BE MADE WITHOUT MUCHEA WATER'S APPROVAL. PENALTY FINE OF \$10,000 APPLIES.
